Many of the Scriptures in this discourse; mostly in the order referred to.

Jer 24:5 "Thus says the LORD God of Israel, **'Like these good figs**, so I will regard as good the captives of Judah, whom I have sent out of this place into the land of the Chaldeans. Jer 24:6 'For I will set My eyes on them for good, and **I will bring them again to this land**; and I will build them up and not overthrow them, and <u>I will plant them and not pluck them up</u>. Jer 24:7 'I will give them a heart to know Me, for I am the LORD; and they will be My people, and I will be their God, for **they will return to Me with their whole heart.**

Matt 23:38 "Behold, your house is being left to you desolate!

Mat 23:39 "For I say to you, from now on you will not see Me until you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!'"

Jer 16:18 "I will first **doubly** repay their iniquity and their sin, because they have polluted My land; they have filled My inheritance with the carcasses of their detestable idols and with their abominations."

Isa 40:1 "Comfort, O comfort My people," says your God.

Isa 40:2 "**Speak kindly to Jerusalem;** And call out to her, that her warfare has ended, That her iniquity has been removed, That she has received of the LORD'S hand **Double** for all her sins."

Psa 102:13 You will arise and have compassion on Zion; For it is time to be gracious to her, For the appointed time has come.

Zech 9:12 Return to the stronghold, O prisoners who have the hope; **This very day** I am declaring that I will restore double to you.

Zech 9:13 For I will bend Judah as My bow, I will fill the bow with Ephraim. And I will stir up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece; And I will make you like a warrior's sword.

Isa 52:1 **Awake, awake**, Clothe yourself in your strength, O Zion; Clothe yourself in your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city; For the uncircumcised and the unclean Will no longer come into you.

Isa 52:2 Shake yourself from the dust, rise up, O captive Jerusalem; Loose yourself from the chains around your neck, O captive daughter of Zion.

Ezek 37:11 Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel; behold, they say, 'Our bones are dried up and our hope has perished. We are completely cut off.'

Eze 37:12 "Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "**Behold, I will open your graves** and cause you to come up out of your graves, **My people; and I will bring you into the land of Israel**.

Eze 37:13 "Then you will know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves and caused you to come up out of your graves, My people.

Eze 37:14 "I will put My Spirit within you and you will come to life, and I will place you on your own land. Then you will know that I, the LORD, have spoken and done it," declares the LORD.'"

Act 3:12 But when Peter saw this, he replied to the people, "Men of Israel, why are you amazed at this, or why do you gaze at us, as if by our own power or piety we had made him walk?

Act 3:19 "Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord;

Act 3:20 and that He may send Jesus, the Christ appointed for you,

Act 3:21 whom heaven must receive until the period of restoration of all things about which God spoke by the mouth of His holy prophets from ancient time.

Dan 12:1 "Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands guard over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time **your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued**. ("delivered" KJV, Leeser, NIV, ASV, JPS)

Jer 16:14 "Therefore behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when it will no longer be said, 'As the LORD lives, who brought up the sons of Israel out of the land of Egypt,'

Jer 16:15 but, 'As the LORD lives, who brought up the sons of Israel from the land of the north and from all the countries where He had banished them.' **For I will restore them to their own land which I gave to their fathers**.

Jer 16:16 "Behold, I am going to send for many fishermen," declares the LORD, "and they will fish for them; and afterwards I will send for many hunters, and they will hunt them from every mountain and every hill and from the clefts of the rocks.

Rom 11:26 and **so all Israel will be saved**; just as it is written, "THE DELIVERER WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB."

Amo 9:14 "Also I will restore the captivity of My people Israel, **And they will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them**; They will also plant vineyards and drink their wine, And make gardens and eat their fruit.

Jer 31:3 The LORD appeared to him from afar, saying, "**I have loved you with an everlasting love**; Therefore I have drawn you with lovingkindness.

Jer 31:4 "Again I will build you and you will be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! Again you will take up your tambourines, And go forth to the dances of the merrymakers.

Jer 31:5 "Again you will plant vineyards On the hills of Samaria (West Bank); The planters will plant And will enjoy them.

Jer 31:6 "For there will be a day when watchmen On **the hills of Ephraim** (part of the West Bank) call out, 'Arise, and let us go up to Zion, To the LORD our God.'"

Jer 31:7 For thus says the LORD, "**Sing aloud with gladness for Jacob**, And **shout among the chief of the nations**; Proclaim, give praise and say, 'O LORD, save Your people, The remnant of Israel.'

Zeph 3:16 In that day it will be said to Jerusalem: "Do not be afraid, O Zion; Do not let your hands fall limp.

Luke 21:29 Then He told them a parable: "Behold the fig tree and all the trees;

Luk 21:30 as soon as they put forth leaves, you see it and know for yourselves that summer is now near (ready).

Luk 21:31 "So you also, when you see these things happening, recognize that the kingdom of God is near.

Luk 21:32 "Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all things take place.

Luk 21:33 "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away.

2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which **the heavens** will **pass away** with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and **the earth** and its works will be burned up.

<u>Rev 20:11</u> Then I saw a great white throne and **Him who sat upon it**, from whose presence **earth** and **heaven fled away**, and no place was found for them.

Zep 2:3 Seek the LORD, All you humble of the earth Who have carried out His ordinances; Seek righteousness, seek humility. **Perhaps you will be hidden In the day of the LORD'S anger**. Zeph 2:4 **For Gaza** will be abandoned And Ashkelon **a desolation**; Ashdod will be driven out at noon And Ekron will be uprooted.

Zep 2:5 Woe to the inhabitants of the seacoast, The nation of the Cherethites! The word of the LORD is against you, O Canaan, land of the Philistines (so-called Palestinians); And I will destroy you So that there will be no inhabitant.

Zep 2:6 So the seacoast will be pastures, With caves for shepherds and folds for flocks.

Zep 2:7 **And the coast will be For the remnant of the house of Judah**, They will pasture on it. In the houses of Ashkelon they will lie down at evening; For the LORD their God will care for them And restore their fortune.

Jer 30:11 'For I am with you,' declares the LORD, **'to save you**; For I will **destroy completely all the nations** where I have scattered you, Only I will not destroy you completely. But I will chasten you justly And will by no means leave you unpunished.'

Jer 30:12 "For thus says the LORD, 'Your wound is incurable And your injury is serious.

Jer 30:13 'There is no one to plead your cause; No healing for your sore, No recovery for you. Jer 30:14 **'All your lovers have forgotten you**, They do not seek you; For I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy, With the punishment of a cruel one, Because your iniquity is great And your sins are numerous.

Zech 12:3 "It will come about in that day that **I will make Jerusalem a heavy stone for all the peoples**; all who lift it will be severely injured. And **all the nations of the earth will be gathered against it.**

Zec 12:4 "In that day," declares the LORD, "I will strike every horse with bewilderment and his rider with madness. But I will watch over the house of Judah, while I strike every horse of the peoples with blindness.

Zec 12:5 "Then the clans of Judah will say in their hearts, 'A strong support for us are the inhabitants of Jerusalem through the LORD of hosts, their God.'

Zec 12:6 "In that day I will make the clans of Judah like a firepot among pieces of wood and a flaming torch among sheaves, so they will consume on the right hand and on the left all the surrounding peoples, while the inhabitants of Jerusalem again dwell on their own sites in Jerusalem.

Zec 12:7 "The LORD also will save the tents of Judah first, so that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem will not be magnified above Judah.

Zech 12:8 "In that day **the LORD will defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem**, and the one who is feeble among them in that day will be like David, and the house of David will be like God, like the angel of the LORD before them.

Zec 12:9 "And in that day I will set about to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

Zep 2:8 "I have heard the taunting of **Moab** And the revilings of the sons of **Ammon**, With which they have taunted My people And become arrogant against their territory. Zep 2:9 "Therefore, as I live," declares the LORD of hosts, The God of Israel, "Surely **Moab will be like Sodom And the sons of Ammon like Gomorrah-**- A place possessed by nettles and salt pits, And a perpetual desolation. The remnant of My people will plunder them And the remainder of My nation will inherit them."

Micah 7:14 Shepherd Your people with Your scepter, The flock of Your possession Which dwells by itself in the woodland, In the midst of a fruitful field. Let them feed in **Bashan and Gilead** As in the days of old. (Bashan is the Golan Heights and Gilead -part of the East Bank/Jordan River)

Mic 7:15 "As in the days when you came out from the land of Egypt, I will show you miracles."

Joel 3:2 I will **gather all the nations And bring them down to the valley of Jehoshaphat**. Then I will enter into judgment with them there On behalf of **My people** and **My inheritance**, Israel, Whom they have scattered among the nations; And **they have divided up** <u>My land</u>.

Obadiah 1:17 "But on Mount Zion there will be those who escape, And it will be holy. And the house of Jacob will possess their possessions.

Oba 1:18 "Then the house of Jacob will be a fire And the house of Joseph a flame; But the **house of Esau will be as stubble**. And they will set them on fire and consume them, So that there will be **no survivor of the house of Esau**," For the LORD has spoken.

Oba 1:19 Then those of **the Negev** will possess the mountain of Esau, And those of the **Shephelah** the Philistine plain; Also, possess the territory of Ephraim and **the territory of Samaria**, **And Benjamin will possess Gilead**.

Oba 1:20 And the exiles of this host of the sons of Israel, Who are among the Canaanites **as far as Zarephath**, And the exiles of Jerusalem who are in Sepharad Will possess the cities of the Negev.

Ezek 38:19 "In My zeal and in My blazing wrath I declare that on that day there will surely be a **great earthquake in the land of Israel**.

Eze 38:20 "The fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all the creeping things that creep on the earth, and all the men who are on the face of the earth **will shake at My presence;** the mountains also will be thrown down, the steep pathways will collapse and every wall will fall to the ground.

Eze 38:21 "I will call for a sword against him on all My mountains," declares the Lord GOD. "Every man's sword will be against his brother.

Rev 16:18 And there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder; and there was **a great earthquake**, such as there had not been since man came to be upon the earth, so great an earthquake was it, and so mighty.

Zech 14:9 And the LORD will be **king over all the earth**; in that day the LORD will be the only one, and His name the only one.

Zech 8:22 'So many peoples and mighty nations will come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem and to entreat the favor of the LORD.'

Zec 8:23 "Thus says the LORD of hosts, 'In those days ten men from all the nations will grasp the garment of a Jew, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.""

Isa 2:2 Now it will come about that In the last days The mountain of the house of the LORD Will be established as the chief of the mountains, And will be raised above the hills; And all the nations will stream to it.

Isa 2:3 And many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, To the house of the God of Jacob; That He may teach us concerning His ways And that we may walk in His paths." **For the law will go forth from Zion And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem**.

Jer 31:27 "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will sow the house of Israel and the house of Judah with the seed of man and with the seed of beast.

Jer 31:28 "As I have watched over them to pluck up, to break down, to overthrow, to destroy and to bring disaster, so I will watch over them **to build and to plant**," declares the LORD.

Jer 31:29 "In those days they will not say again, 'The fathers have eaten sour grapes, And the children's teeth are set on edge.'

Jer 31:30 "But everyone will die for his own iniquity; each man who eats the sour grapes, his teeth will be set on edge.

Jer 31:31 "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make **a new covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah,

Jer 31:32 not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the LORD.

Jer 31:33 "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the LORD, "I will put My law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

<u>Jer 31:34</u> "They will not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' **for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them**," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

Micah 4:1 And it will come about in the last days That the mountain of the house of the LORD Will be established as the chief of the mountains. It will be raised above the hills, And the peoples will stream to it.

Mic 4:2 Many nations will come and say, "Come and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD And to the house of the God of Jacob, That He may teach us about His ways And that we may walk in His paths." For from Zion will go forth the law, Even the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Mic 4:3 And He will judge between many peoples And render decisions for mighty, distant nations. Then they will hammer their swords into plowshares And their spears into pruning hooks; **Nation will not lift up sword against nation, And never again will they train for war**.

Mic 4:4 **Each of them will sit under his vine And under his fig tree**, With no one to make them afraid, For the mouth of the LORD of hosts has spoken.

Mic 4:5 Though all the peoples walk Each in the name of his god, As for us, we will walk In the name of the LORD our God forever and ever.

Zeph 3:15 The LORD has taken away His judgments against you, He has cleared away your enemies. The King of Israel, the LORD, is in your midst; You will fear disaster no more.

Zep 3:16 In that day **it will be said to Jerusalem: "Do not be afraid**, O Zion; Do not let your hands fall limp.

Zep 3:17 "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.

Zeph 3:18 "I will gather those who grieve about the appointed feasts-- They came from you, O Zion; The reproach of exile is a burden on them.

Zep 3:19 "Behold, I am going to deal at that time With all your oppressors, I will save the lame And gather the outcast, **And I will turn their shame into praise and renown In all the earth**.

Zep 3:20 "At that time I will bring you in, Even at the time when I gather you together; Indeed, **I will give you renown and praise Among all the peoples of the earth**, When I restore your fortunes before your eyes," Says the LORD.
